Bow inspection for the following features: No magnification in sight, screw-in field points, camo bow with bow quiver. Longbow entrants may have back quiver & wooden arrows with glued field points; screw-in field points if using aluminium or carbon shafts.

Senior Open Compound, scope / adjustable sight, Release Aid, any stabiliser, 17 years +

Senior Unlimited Compound, fixed pin sights only, Release Aid, any stabiliser, 17 years +

Senior Limited Sighted Compound / Recurve, Fingers, any sight, scope or stabiliser, 17 +

Senior Barebow Compound Finger release, 17 years +

Junior Open Compound, scope / adjustable sight, Release Aid, any stabiliser, 13 – 16 yrs

Junior Unlimited Compound fixed pin sights only, Release Aid, any stabiliser, 13 – 16 yrs

Junior Limited Sighted Compound / Recurve, Fingers, any sight, scope or stabiliser, 13 – 16

Junior Barebow Compound, Finger release, 13 – 16

Longbow Longbow only, unsighted

Recurve Any recurve bow, unsighted

Cubs Limited up to 13 years, compound or recurve, sighted, fingers

Cubs Barebow up to 13 years, compound or recurve, unsighted
